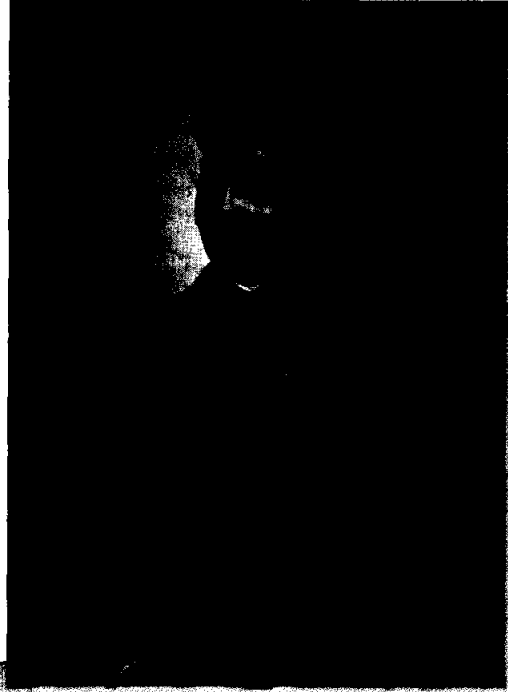

REPORT OF THE PRESIDENT TO THE MEMBERS

I have pleasure in presenting my report for the year 1999-2000 to the members of the Association. **The Hospital has now entered its Platinum Jubilee year.**

After making a modest beginning in the year 1925 with 40 beds, half of them free, this Hospital has come a long way in its endeavour to provide total health care under one roof. As the oldest private hospital in the city, it attracted eminent medical professionals. The spirit of care and service continues to guide us. During the past 74 eventful years the Hospital has treated 506562 patients and conducted 233940 surgeries. The blessings of the patients and their dear ones continue to be the source of strength for the Hospital.

Two years ago, the Executive Committee and the Managing Council were reconstituted after the nominees of the Dhirubhai Ambani Foundation (DAF) were inducted on the Management of Hospital. A survey was carried out of patients discharged from our hospital, their relatives and also the General Practitioners in the neighbouring area. The feedback received has encouraged us to expedite a major renovation to the existing facilities and services of the Hospital including addition to the biomedical engineering equipment identified by our Hon. Medical Consultants.

During the past one year the Hospital has undertaken several renovations and made considerable headway with the planning of New Complex project, thanks to the personal interest and direct involvement of Ms. Nita M. Ambani, President, DAF. These renovation and repair works have helped in improving the condition in the wards as well as other facilities in the Hospital. I would like to highlight here some of the important facilities which have been renovated.

The following areas were renovated and recommissioned :

1. The Casualty services are housed in a much larger area with better facilities including a room for procedures and a few Day-Care Beds.
2. Arab Building was in a dilapidated condition and alternative proposals for development of plots of Arab and Janmashatami Buildings are being evolved.
3. An improved kitchen has replaced the old conventional kitchen of the Hospital.
I am happy to note that the staff manning the kitchen have adapted well to the new layout and equipment. It may be recalled that our hospital enjoys a good reputation for its 'homely' food.
4. An Intermediate Care Unit (IMCU) with 12 beds is now established, and offers more professional care than what is feasible in the regular ward, for the patients who need a little more clinical attention This has helped reduce pressure on ICU/ICCU Beds .
5. All the Operation Theatres, the ICCU and the ICU have been renovated.
6. To meet the aspirations of our Hon. Medical Consultants, the Pediatric Ward has been remodelled and renovated incorporating the valuable suggestions from them, and later the Obstetric & Gynaecology Ward on the same floor has been commissioned. Earlier, Nurses Lecture Hall was converted into a Functional Auditorium-cum-class rooms. The facilities on the third floor of the Kapole Niwas Building now offer improved and effective services.

Facilities are now available for parking more cars near the New Complex. A larger parking area is planned in the near future to meet the emerging requirement.
