2. Performance

The substantial increase in Other Income and Profits of the Company has been significantly contributed by the sale of Rig Aban I in October 1997, taking advantage of the boom in the international rig market. The reduction in the Income from Operations, during the year under review, has to be seen in the background of completing the sale and installation of all the wind energy turbines in the inventory during the previous year.

3. Operations

(a) Drilling Services

The Company has entered into a new contract for Rig Ile D' Amsterdam with increased rates, valid in the first instance for a period of two years. Aban Il is under contract with ONGC, but the Company is also exploring the possibility for deployment at better terms in the Middle East and adjacent countries. Keeping in view the new exploration policies and programmes of ONGC, the Company has kept under constant review the emerging opportunities for revamping its fleet.

(b) Wind Energy

The expected revenue from the sale of power from wind energy has suffered on account of problems faced due to unstable grid conditions and the consequent adverse effect on the performance of the equipment and the damage to it sensitive components. In the absence of technical support from the suppliers of wind turbines, the Company had to evolve and innovate indigenous spares and Operations & Maintenance systems. As a result of these efforts, it is expected that the performance would show progressively better results and revenues.

4. Diversification

The proposal for setting up of a 3 million tonne capacity Petroleum Refinery continues to be under hold in view of the uncertainties in the capital market. The Company will take a suitable decision in this matter at an appropriate time. As regards the diversification into Power Sector, the Company has been selected by Tamil Nadu Government for setting up a 103 MW power plant on Build, Own and Operate basis near Ennore. The Company has assigned the project to M/s.Aban Power Company Ltd. formed as a Company separately for generation of power.

Dividend

The Directors are pleased to recommend a higher Dividend of 45% on the paid up equity capital, as a gesture of sharing the realisation to the Company, on the sale of Rig Aban I, during the year.

6. Directors

Mr.V.S. Rao and Mr.Reji Abraham retire by rotation, and being eligible, offer themselves for reappointment.

7. Auditors

M/s.Ford, Rhodes, Parks & Co, Chartered Accountants, Chennai hold office until conclusion of the ensuing Annual General Meeting, and being eligible, are recommended for reappointment.

8. Particulars of employees

As required by the provisions of Section 217(2A) of the Companies Act, 1956 read with the Companies (Particulars of Employees) Rules 1975, the names and relevant particulars of the employees is enclosed in Annexure which forms a part of this Report.

9. In terms of Section 217(1) of the Companies Act, 1956 (as amended) and the Companies (Disclosure of particulars in Report of the Board of Directors) Rules 1988, your Directors furnish hereunder the additional information as required.

A. Conservation of Energy

The activities of the Company are not energy intensive. However, efforts are being taken to maintain consumption of energy at realistic levels.

B. Research and Development carried out by the Company

- (a) The Company has been making efforts to indigenise various components and structures of the Wind Turbine Generators and has been able to successfully develop some of the components indigenously.
- (b) The Company's activities in R&D are mainly directed towards training and upgrading of the skills of the operating personnel and import substitution of equipments, tools and spares.

C. Technology Absorption and Innovation

Measures are constantly being taken to maximise the indigenisation of the operations of the Rig with a view to reducing the dependence on imported inputs.
