












ACC is proud to have been among the first few Indian companies to include commitment to environmental protection as a corporate objective.

### Providing Education for Society's Future


ACC schools in our townships continue to mainteln high educational standards. These are open to all dalidren of the Vicinity.


ACC entered partnerships with several State Governments and industry associations to upgrade the quality of education at Industrial Training histitutes (ITI) located near our plants.
