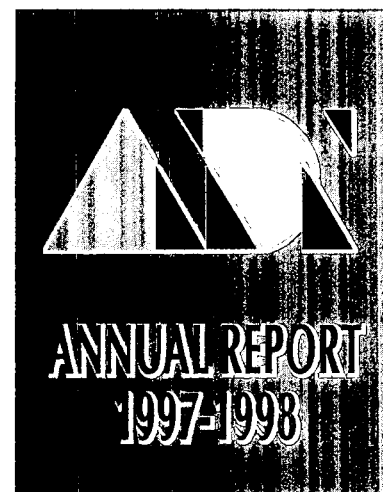

TO THE MEMBERS

Your Directors have pleasure in presenting their Report on the business and operations of the Company for the year ended 31st March 1998.

OPERATIONS

During the year under review your Company earned a total income of Rs. 3924.58 lacs as against Rs. 2871.27 lacs in the previous year, which represents an increase of 36.68%. The operation of the Company resulted in a net profit of Rs. 40.25 lacs. The profits were under pressure due to substantial depreciation in the value of Rupees and intense competition marked by low price.

In view of the lower profits and to conserve resources, your Directors do not recommend dividend for the year under review.

NEW PRODUCTS

Your Directors are pleased to inform you that your Company has successfully set up a Software Technology Park Unit (STP). The STP has been set up to explore and tap the vast Software Product/Project markets in United States of America and Europe. With the diversification in the Software production, your Company hopes to increase the revenue and profits in the coming years.

TIE-UPS

1. **NITINOL MEDICAL TECHNOLOGIES, USA:** Your Company tied-up with Nitinol Medical Technologies, USA to promote their products in India.

Nitinol manufactures a revolutionary product called

Cardioseal, which is a septal Occlusion System. This product is used to correct very common congenital defects like Arterial Septal defects and Ventricular Septal defects. For these types of defects, open-heart surgery was the only course. However, with these devices, these defects can be treated in Cardiac Cath Lab and Open Heart surgeries can be avoided with no compromise on patient safety and with excellent results.

2. DELL COMPUTER CORPORATION:

DELL Computer Corporation, a top Computer Company has appointed your Company as one of its Direct Distributors. DELL is among the top 200 Fortune 500 Companies. For AMDL, the association with DELL is a major happening. DELL is now among the top 3 in PC and server markets and has been known for providing relevant technology products at the most competitive price. It will enable us to offer the latest technology products to the IT community at the same time it is available in US at a Competitive price.

CONSERVATION OF ENERGY:

Despite the fact that the operation of the Company involves low energy consumption, emphasis is laid on conservation of energy at all levels of operations.

RESEARCH & DEVELOPMENT

Your Company continues to pursue R&D activities vigorously. R&D is recognised by Department of Science and Technology, Government of India. With increasing liberalisation, where import of products and services has been made easier and more economical, the R&D is also now focusing more on software development in line with software exports.

The recurring expenditure incurred on Research & Development during the year ended 31st March 1998 was Rs.18.23 lacs which amounts to 0.46 % of Sales Turnover.

FOREIGN EXCHANGE EARNINGS & OUTGO

The Foreign Exchange earnings during the year under review was Rs. 215.34 lacs. The total Foreign Exchange utilised by the Company during the year was Rs. 1723.26 lakhs.
