- 1. The Ministry of Corporate Affairs ('MCA') vide its General Circular No.10/2022 dated December 28, 2022 read with General Circulars No. 14/2020 dated April 8, 2020, No.17/2020 dated April 13, 2020, No.20/2020 dated May 5, 2020, No.02/2021 January 13, 2021, No.19/2021 dated December 8, 2021, No. 21/2021 dated December 14, 2021, No. 02/2022 dated May 5, 2022 ("MCA Circulars") and SEBI vide its Circular SEBI/HO/CFD/PoD-2/P/CIR/2023/4 dated January 05, 2023 have permitted Companies to hold Annual General Meeting ("AGM") through Video Conferencing ("VC") or Other Audio Visual Means ("OAVM") and extended relaxation in respect of sending physical copies of annual report to Shareholders till September 30, 2023.
- 2. In compliance with the applicable provisions of the Companies Act, 2013 (the "Companies Act"), Securities and Exchange Board of India (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015, as amended (the "Listing Regulations"), MCA Circulars, SEBI Circulars, Secretarial Standard II on General Meetings ("SS-II") issued by the Institute of the Company Secretaries of India and other applicable laws, if any, the 61st AGM of the Company will be held on Friday, the 15th day of September, 2023 at 10.00 a.m. (IST), through VC/OAVM which does not require the physical presence of members at a common venue.
- 3. Since this AGM is being held through VC/OAVM, the requirement of physical attendance of the members has been dispensed with. Accordingly, in terms of MCA circulars and the SEBI circular, the facility for appointment of proxies by the members will not be available for this AGM and hence the Proxy Form, Attendance Slip and Route Map of AGM are not annexed to this notice.
- 4. The Company has engaged Central Depository Services (India) Limited (CDSL) to provide the VC facility for conducting the AGM and for voting through remote e-voting and e-voting at the AGM. The procedure for participating in the meeting through VC/OAVM, forms part of this Notice.
- 5. Institutional Investors and Corporate Shareholders, who are Members of the Company, are encouraged to attend and vote at the 61st AGM through VC/OAVM facility. Corporate Members intending to appoint their authorized representatives pursuant to Section 112 and 113 of the Act, as the case may be, to attend the AGM through VC/OAVM or to vote through remote e-Voting are requested to send a certified copy of the Board Resolution/ authorization letter together with attested specimen signature of the duly authorized representative(s) to the Scrutinizer by email at kjr@mdassociates.co.in with a copy marked to helpdesk.evoting@cdslindia.com.
- The attendance of the Members attending the AGM through VC/OAVM will be counted for the purpose of reckoning the quorum under section 103 of the Act.
- 7. Manner for Registration of e-mail addresses is as follows:

For Physical Shareholders: Members who have not registered their e-mail address with the Company, can register their e-mail address for receipt of Notice of 61st AGM, Annual Report and login details for joining the 61st AGM through VC/OAVM facility including e-voting by sending a request to MCS Share Transfer Agent Limited (MCS), Registrar and Share Transfer Agent (RTA) at helpdeskmum@mcsregistrars.com providing their

name, folio number, scanned copy of the share certificate (front and back), self-attested scanned copy of the PAN card and self-attested scanned copy of Aadhaar card) in support for registering e-mail address.

For Demat Shareholders: Members holding shares in demat form whose e-mail address are not registered, are requested to register their e-mail address for receipt of Notice of 61st AGM, Annual Report and login details for joining the 61st AGM through VC/OAVM facility including e-voting by providing Demat account details (CDSL -16 digit beneficiary ID or NSDL - 16 digit DPID+CLID), Name, Client Master or copy of Consolidated Account Statement, PAN (self-attested scanned copy of the PAN card), AADHAAR (self-attested scanned copy of the AADHAAR card) to their DP only, as per the process advised by their DP. The registered email address will also be used for sending future communications.

- 8. Pursuant to the MCA and SEBI Circulars, the Annual Report including the Notice of the AGM for the FY 2022-2023 is being sent by electronic mode to all members whose email addresses are registered with the Company/Depository Participants (DPs). The Company shall send a physical copy of the Annual Report to those Members who specifically request for the same at cs@ahlchennai.com; directorsaruna@gmail.com; mentioning their Folio No./ DP ID and Client ID. The Notice convening the 61st AGM has been uploaded on the website of the Company at www.arunahotels.com and may also be accessed on the website of the stock exchange BSE Limited at www.bseindia.com and in the website of CDSL at www.evotingindia.com.
- The Notice of AGM along with the Annual Report will be sent to those members/beneficial owners whose name
 appear in the register of members/list of beneficiaries received from the depositories as on Friday, 18th August,
 2023.
- 10. The Company's Registrar and Share Transfer Agents (RTA) for its Share Registry Work (Physical and Electronic) are M/s. MCS Share Transfer Agents Limited, having their office premises at 3B3, 3rd Floor, Gundecha Onclave, Kherani Road, Sakinaka, Andheri (E), Mumbai 400072. The Register of Members and Transfer Books of the Company will be closed from September 09, 2023, Saturday to September 15, 2023, Friday (both days inclusive).
- 11. As per Regulation 40 of the SEBI Listing Regulations, as amended, securities of the listed companies can be transferred/ transmitted only in dematerialized form with effect from April 01, 2019. In view of this and to eliminate all risks associated with physical shares, members holding shares in physical form are requested to convert their holdings in dematerialized form. Members can contact the Company or Company's Registrar and Share Transfer Agent (RTA) for assistance in this regard.

SEBI vide its Circular dated November 03, 2021 and March 16, 2023, mandated furnishing of PAN, KYC details (postal address with Pin code, mobile number, bank account details) and Nomination by holders of physical securities through Form ISR-1, Form ISR-2, Form ISR-3, Form SH-13 and Form SH-14 (as applicable). The format of the said forms is also available in the website of the Company at www.arunahotels.com --->Investor Relations --->SEBI KYC Forms. In terms of above Circular, folios of physical shareholders wherein any one of the said details such as PAN, KYC details and nomination are not available, shall be frozen with effect from October 1, 2023 and such physical shareholders will not be eligible to lodge grievances or avail service requests from the RTA of the Company and will not be eligible for receipt of dividend in physical mode until the said details are furnished. The securities once frozen will revert to normal status only upon receipt of requisite KYC documents or upon dematerialization of the said securities. Therefore, Members holding share(s) in physical form are requested to immediately update their KYC details / dematerialise their shareholding in the Company. Demat Holders may update with the concerned Depository Participant (DP) where the demat account is maintained.

Further, Shareholders holding shares in physical mode are requested to ensure that their PAN is linked to Aadhaar by June 30, 2023 or any other date as specified by the Central Board of Direct Taxes to avoid freezing of folio.

Further, as per the above SEBI circular, the frozen folios shall be referred by RTA/ Company to the administering authority under the Benami Transactions (Prohibitions) Act, 1988 and Prevention of Money Laundering Act, 2002, after December 31, 2025.

12. As per the provisions of Section 72 of the Act, the facility for making nomination is available for the Members in respect of the shares held by them. Members who have not yet registered their nomination are requested to register the same by submitting Form No. SH-13. If a Member desires to opt out or cancel the earlier nomination and record fresh nomination, he/she may submit the same in Form ISR-3 or Form SH-14, as applicable. The said forms can be downloaded from the Company's website at www.arunahotels.com and from the website of the RTA at www.mcsregistrars.com. Members are requested to submit the said form to their DP in case the shares are held by them in electronic form and to the RTA at helpdeskmum@mcsregistrars.com in case the shares are held in physical form, quoting their folio no.

- 13. Members holding shares in physical form, in identical order of names, in more than one folio are requested to send to the Company or RTA, the details of such folios together with the share certificates for consolidating their holdings in one folio. A consolidated share certificate will be issued to such Members after making requisite changes.
- 14. To support the 'Green Initiative', Members who have not yet registered their email addresses are requested to register the same with their DPs in case the shares are held by them in electronic form and with the Company / RTA in case the shares are held by them in physical form.
- 15. In case of joint holders, the Member whose name appears as the first holder in the order of names as per the Register of Members of the Company will be entitled to vote at the AGM.
- 16. All documents referred to in the Notice will be available electronically for inspection without any fee by the members from the date of circulation of this Notice up to the date of the AGM i.e., Friday, the 15th day of September, 2023. - 17. The Register of Directors & Key Managerial Personnel and their Shareholding, Register of Contracts or Arrangements in which Director are interested will be available for electronic inspection by the members during the AGM.

- 20. Mr. M. Damodaran, Managing Partner of M. Damodaran & Associates LLP, Practicing Company Secretaries, has been appointed as the Scrutinizer to scrutinize the voting during the AGM and remote e-voting process in a fair and transparent manner.
- 21. Members are requested to carefully read the below instructions in connection with remote e-Voting and procedure for joining the AGM.

THE INSTRUCTIONS FOR SHAREHOLDERS FOR REMOTE E-VOTING ARE AS UNDER:

CDSL e-Voting System – for e-Voting and joining virtual meetings

- 1. As you are aware, in view of the situation arising due to COVID-19 global pandemic, the general meetings of the companies shall be conducted as per the guidelines issued by the Ministry of Corporate Affairs (MCA) vide Circular No. 14/2020 dated April 8, 2020, Circular No.17/2020 dated April 13, 2020 and Circular No. 20/2020 dated May 05, 2020. The forthcoming AGM will thus be held through video conferencing (VC) or other audio visual means (OAVM). Hence, Members can attend and participate in the ensuing AGM through VC/OAVM.
- 2. Pursuant to the provisions of Section 108 of the Companies Act, 2013 read with Rule 20 of the Companies (Management and Administration) Rules, 2014 (as amended) and Regulation 44 of SEBI (Listing Obligations & Disclosure Requirements) Regulations 2015 (as amended), and MCA Circulars dated April 08, 2020, April 13, 2020 and May 05, 2020 the Company is providing facility of remote e-voting to its Members in respect of the business to be transacted at the AGM/EGM. For this purpose, the Company has entered into an agreement with Central Depository Services (India) Limited (CDSL) for facilitating voting through electronic means, as the authorized e-Voting's agency. The facility of casting votes by a member using remote e-voting as well as the e-voting system on the date of the AGM will be provided by CDSL.
- 3. The Members can join the AGM in the VC/OAVM mode 15 minutes before and after the scheduled time of the commencement of the Meeting by following the procedure mentioned in the Notice. The facility of participation at the AGM through VC/OAVM will be made available to atleast 1000 members on first come first served basis. This will not include large Shareholders (Shareholders holding 2% or more shareholding), Promoters, Institutional Investors, Directors, Key Managerial Personnel, the Chairpersons of the Audit Committee, Nomination and Remuneration Committee and Stakeholders Relationship Committee, Auditors etc. who are allowed to attend the AGM without restriction on account of first come first served basis.
- The attendance of the Members attending the AGM through VC/OAVM will be counted for the purpose of ascertaining the quorum under Section 103 of the Companies Act, 2013.

- 5. Pursuant to MCA Circular No. 14/2020 dated April 08, 2020, the facility to appoint proxy to attend and cast vote for the members is not available for this AGM. However, in pursuance of Section 112 and Section 113 of the Companies Act, 2013, representatives of the members such as the President of India or the Governor of a State or body corporate can attend the AGM through VC/OAVM and cast their votes through e-voting.
- 6. In line with the Ministry of Corporate Affairs (MCA) Circular No. 17/2020 dated April 13, 2020, the Notice calling the AGM has been uploaded on the website of the Company at www.arunahotels.com. The Notice can also be accessed from the website of the Stock Exchange i.e. BSE Limited at www.bseindia.com. The AGM Notice is also disseminated on the website of CDSL (agency for providing the Remote e-Voting facility and e-voting system during the AGM) i.e.www.evotingindia.com.
- The AGM has been convened through VC/OAVM in compliance with applicable provisions of the Companies Act, 2013 read with MCA Circular No. 14/2020 dated April 8, 2020 and MCA Circular No. 17/2020 dated April 13, 2020 and MCA Circular No. 20/2020 dated May 05, 2020.
- 8. In continuation of this Ministry's **General Circular No. 20/2020**, dated 05th May, 2020 and after due examination, it has been decided to allow companies whose AGMs were due to be held in the year 2020, or become due in the year 2021, to conduct their AGMs on or before 31.12.2021, in accordance with the requirements provided in paragraphs 3 and 4 of the General Circular No. 20/2020 as per MCA circular no. 02/2021 dated January 13,2021.

THE INTRUCTIONS OF SHAREHOLDERS FOR E-VOTING AND JOINING VIRTUAL MEETINGS ARE AS UNDER:

- Step 1: Access through Depositories CDSL/NSDL e-Voting system in case of individual shareholders holding shares in demat mode.
- Step 2: Access through CDSL e-Voting system in case of shareholders holding shares in physical mode and nonindividual shareholders in demat mode.
- (i) The voting period begins on Tuesday, the 12th September, 2023 and ends on Thursday, the 14th September 2023. During this period shareholders' of the Company, holding shares either in physical form or in dematerialized form, as on the cut-off date (record date) of Thursday, the 7th September, 2023 may cast their vote electronically. The e-voting module shall be disabled by CDSL for voting thereafter.
- (ii) Shareholders who have already voted prior to the meeting date would not be entitled to vote at the meeting venue
- (iii) Pursuant to SEBI Circular No. SEBI/HO/CFD/CMD/CIR/P/2020/242 dated 09.12.2020, under Regulation 44 of Securities and Exchange Board of India (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015, listed entities are required to provide remote e-voting facility to its shareholders, in respect of all shareholders' resolutions. However, it has been observed that the participation by the public non-institutional shareholders/retail shareholders is at a negligible level.

Currently, there are multiple e-voting service providers (ESPs) providing e-voting facility to listed entities in India. This necessitates registration on various ESPs and maintenance of multiple user IDs and passwords by the shareholders.

In order to increase the efficiency of the voting process, pursuant to a public consultation, it has been decided to enable e-voting to all the demat account holders, by way of a single login credential, through their demat accounts/ websites of Depositories/ Depository Participants. Demat account holders would be able to cast their vote without having to register again with the ESPs, thereby, not only facilitating seamless authentication but also enhancing ease and convenience of participating in e-voting process.

- Step 1: Access through Depositories CDSL/NSDL e-Voting system in case of individual shareholders holding shares in demat mode.
- (iv) In terms of SEBI circular no. SEBI/HO/CFD/CMD/CIR/P/2020/242 dated December 9, 2020 on e-Voting facility provided by Listed Companies, Individual shareholders holding securities in demat mode are allowed to vote through their demat account maintained with Depositories and Depository Participants. Shareholders are advised to update their mobile number and email Id in their demat accounts in order to access e-Voting facility.

- (v) Login method for e-Voting and joining virtual meetings for **Physical shareholders and shareholders other than** individual holding in **Demat form.**
- 1) The shareholders should log on to the e-voting website www.evotingindia.com.
- 2) Click on "Shareholders" module.
- 3) Now enter your User ID
 - a. For CDSL: 16 digits beneficiary ID,
 - b. For NSDL: 8 Character DP ID followed by 8 Digits Client ID,
 - c. Shareholders holding shares in Physical Form should enter Folio Number registered with the Company.

- (vii) Shareholders holding shares in physical form will then directly reach the Company selection screen. However, shareholders holding shares in demat form will now reach 'Password Creation' menu wherein they are required to mandatorily enter their login password in the new password field. Kindly note that this password is to be also used by the demat holders for voting for resolutions of any other company on which they are eligible to vote, provided that company opts for e-voting through CDSL platform. It is strongly recommended not to share your password with any other person and take utmost care to keep your password confidential.
- (viii) For shareholders holding shares in physical form, the details can be used only for e-voting on the resolutions contained in this Notice.
- (ix) Click on the EVSN for the relevant ARUNA HOTELS LIMITED on which you choose to vote.

- (x) On the voting page, you will see "RESOLUTION DESCRIPTION" and against the same the option "YES/NO" for voting. Select the option YES or NO as desired. The option YES implies that you assent to the Resolution and option NO implies that you dissent to the Resolution.
- (xi) Click on the "RESOLUTIONS FILE LINK" if you wish to view the entire Resolution details.

- (xiii) Once you "CONFIRM" your vote on the resolution, you will not be allowed to modify your vote.
- (xiv) You can also take a print of the votes cast by clicking on "Click here to print" option on the Voting page.
- (xv) If a demat account holder has forgotten the login password then Enter the User ID and the image verification code and click on Forgot Password & enter the details as prompted by the system.
- (xvi) There is also an optional provision to upload BR/POA if any uploaded, which will be made available to scrutinizer for verification.

(xvii) Additional Facility for Non – Individual Shareholders and Custodians –For Remote Voting only.

- Non-Individual shareholders (i.e. other than Individuals, HUF, NRI etc.) and Custodians are required to log on to www.evotingindia.com and register themselves in the "Corporates" module.
