#### **OPERATIONS:**

The coprorate name of the company was changed this year to give effect to the order of Honb'l High Court at Bombay after completing all legal formalities and the present name "BANSISONS TEA INDUSTRIES LIMITED" was duly approved by the Registrar of Companies, West Bengal.

The Company has concentrated its main activities in increasing the tea plantation, maintenance of tea bushes and tea manufacturing. This year the company has substantially expanded the factory building and machinery to achieve higher production target in future.

## **DIVIDEND:**

The Company requires funds for its expansion programme of tea processing unit and as such the profit has been transferred to Reserve & Surplus Account and thereby the company is unable to declare any dividend this year.

## PUBLIC DEPOSIT :

The Company has neither invited nor availed of any public deposits during the year under review.
