- iv. New Pension System (NPS) Trust: Selfdeclaration that it qualifies as NPS trust and income is eligible for exemption under section 10(44) of the Act and being regulated by the provisions of the Indian Trusts Act, 1882 along with self-attested copy of the PAN card.
- v. Other Non-Individual shareholders: Selfattested copy of documentary evidence supporting the exemption along with selfattested copy of PAN card.
