Minutes of the First Annual General Meeting of Coates of India Ltd, held at the registered office of the Company at No. 6 Hastings Street, Calcutta on Monday - The 17th day of December 1949 at 3 P.M.

Present:

1. Mr. P. Gopalvarad, Managing Director (in the Chair)
2. Mr. A. A. Leslie.
3. Mr. Chas. Roberts

1. The notice convening the meeting was read and Mr. Gopalvarad was voted to the Chair.

2. The Chairman placed before the Meeting the Directors and the Auditors Reports respectively for consideration of the Members. Both the reports were duly considered and it was resolved to adopt the same.

3. It was also resolved that a dividend at the rate of 8½ per cent per share for the year ended 31st October 1948 amounting to Rs. 6,319/- be declared for payment to the shareholders and that the balance of the Profits be carried forward.

4. The Chairman asked the meeting to consider and vote on the remuneration of the Directors of the Company and he pointed out to the meeting that Clause 113 of the Articles of the Company provided that the Directors should receive such remuneration for their services a time be determined by the Company or may be contained in an Agreement with any Director. He further informed the meeting that the Directors for attendance at Board by the Company's Articles. 





Customer service


