- (A) As required by the manufacturing and other companies (Auditor's Report) order, 1988 issued by the Company Law Board in terms of section 227(4A) of the Companies Act, 1956 and on the basis of such checks of books and records as were considered appropriate and according to the information and explanations given to us during the course of audit, we give below a statement of the matters specified in the paragraphs 4 & 5 of the said order.
- The Company is maintaining proper records to show full particulars including quantitative details and situation of fixed assets. These fixed assets have been physically verified by the management at reasonable intervals and no discrepancy was noticed on such verification.
- 2. None of the fixed assets have been revalued during the year.
- The Management has conducted physical verification at reasonable intervals in respect of finished goods, stores, spare parts and raw materials.
- 4. The procedures of physical verification of stock followed by the management are, in our opinion, reasonable and adequate in relation to the size of the Company and the nature of its business.
- 5. No significant discrepancy has been noticed on physical verification of stocks as compared to book records and the same has been properly dealt with in the books of account.
