



Equity Share Capital-Net Worth*


Rs in Lakhs

Profit Before Tax-Profit After Tax Rs in Lakhs




Net Block*-Gross Block*




Fertilisers


The expansion of the fertiliser project at Ennore was completed with the commissioning of the Phosphoric Acid Plant in May 1997. The plant design incorporates several new features for higher efficiency and conservation of energy.

This year marks the first full year of operation after the installation of the Ammonia terminal with the submarine pipeline system. This modernisation cum expansion programme has increased production significantly, while reducing operating costs. This is reflected in the record production and off-take of Paramfos.

At Ranipet, the Superphosphate factory registered an all-time high production. A start -up Scrubber at the Sulphuric Acid plant was installed to reduce emission of sulphur dioxide, thereby ensuring that an environment focus is maintained in our operations.







Despite poor monsoon conditions in the primary markets, the sale of formulated products during the year was higher than last year. A diversification strategy in western and northern markets paid off with an impressive rate of growth. Two new products were introduced - a herbicide and a fungicide. The Company has also done significant volumes in toll formulations. Production at Thane was significantly higher than the previous year. Modifications were carried out in all three plants leading to higher productivity and products of better quality. The year has seen growth in the export of technical grade pesticide.

The integrated sugar complex at Nellikuppam, and the Pugalur Sugar Factory recorded a higher recovery of sugar. Sustained efforts were made to improve efficiency and conserve energy in the manufacturing process.

Our pioneering efforts in tissue culture, scientific farming and agro-counselling have resulted in higher yields and ensured the availability of quality cane. All these efforts together with timely offtake and prompt payments enhance the standard of living of over 20,000 cane growers and their families.


Co-generation Plant

The co-generation plant commissioned during the year at Nellikuppam successfully stabilised its operations in record time and exported power to the TNEB. Our plant, which uses bagasse, a by-product of sugar manufacture, and a renewable energy source, is an environment friendly, model co-generation plant.




