Dear Members,

Your Directors present before you their Seventh Annual Report on the affairs and working of the Company together with the audited Final Accounts for the year ended 30th June, 1999 :

FINANCIAL RESULTS :

The working results of the Company for the year ended 30th June, 1999 are as follows:

OPERATIONS:

The business of exports of Fresh Produce from India to developed countries is still in the nascent stage. Nature has a very important part to play in this business and it is most unpredictable.

While in the month of January last year the Crop of grapes looked healthy and was blooming in abundance all over Maharashtra in subsequent months the berry size did not increase, rendering the product unworthy of exports.

Since comparatively better quality grapes were available around Sangli area, larger quantities had to be purchased from there. This resulted in gross underutilization of our Nasik plant. The cost of clearing and forwarding also went up and lower availability of good grapes in Nasik kept the price in and around Sangli higher than in the past all through the season.

The selling price of grapes in Europe in the first week of April was ecouraging. This resulted in a considerable increase in exports of grapes from India especially from the Nasik area during the middle of April. However the quality of this product was not good. This had a bad effect on all Indian grapes. The consumption during this period dropped. The supermarkets did not take the promised deliveries. The Company was therefore compelled to sell substantial quantities in the wholesale markets at a very low price.

Despite initial difficulties, the company expects to do much better in the coming year. It has knowledge, organization and logistics to compete in the international markets. We are confident that the change in the Millenium would usher in a new life in your Company.



DIVIDEND :

In view of loss incurred during the year under report, your Directors regrettably do not recommend any dividend.

DIRECTORS :

Mrs. Nanita Motiani retires by rotation as director of the company but being eligible, offers hereself for reappointment.

FIXED DEPOSIT :

The Company has not accepted any deposit to which the provisions of Section 58-A of the Companies Act, 1956 are applicable.

EROSION OF NET WORTH :

The accumulated losses of the Company as at 30th June, 1999 have resulted into erosion of more than 50% of its peak net worth during the immediately preceding five financial years. Hence the provisions of section 23 of chapter IV of the Sick Industrial Companies (Special Provisions) Act, 1985 relating to potentially sick industrial companies have become applicable to the Company.

PARTICULARS REGARDING EMPLOYEES :

There is no employee who is in receipt of remuneration exceeding the limit specified under Section 217 (2A) of the Companies Act, 1956.

POLLUTION AND ENERGY CONSERVATION ETC :

The Company has installed automatic Power factor controller. All the machines are energy efficient. All refrigeration equipments are thermostatically controlled.

Foreign Exchange earnings during the year amounts to Rs. 396,13,235/-.

and Foreign Exchange outgoings during the year amounts to Rs. 2,65,811/-.

RESEARCH & DEVELOPMENT :

The Company had undertaken project for research & development in agricultural products. For the purpose, the Company had made capital expenditure of Rs. 23192/- on cultivation of fruits on trial basis. Further, Rs. 66.00 Lacs were advanced for purchase of agricultural land. However due to certain discrepancies the Company has not been able to obtain necessary land. Hence the research & development project has been abandoned.

Y2K COMPLIANCE :

None of the Plant & Machinery are operated or supported by computer. The Computers of the Company are Y2K compliant. The software used for fianancial accounting has been upgraded to make it Y2K compliant.

INSURANCE :

The properties of the company except furniture at Ahmedabad office are insured against various perils.

AUDITORS

You are requested to appoint auditors from the conclusion of Annual General Meeting upto the conclusion of the next Annual General Meeting and fix their remuneration. The present Auditors M/s. Nitin K. Shah & Co., Chartered Accountants, are eligible for reappointment.
