Your Directors are pleased to present 11th Annual Report of the Company with the Audited account for the year ended 30th September, 1998 :

2. DIVIDEND

In order to strengthen the financial position of the company and in view of the higher depreciation charges for the year your Directors do not recommend any dividend for the year.

3. REVIEW OF OPERATION

During the year, the company achieved a turnover of Rs. 5222.05 Lacs as against Rs. 4756.12 Lacs in the previous year. This represents an increase of 9.80% over the previous year. The gross profit before financial charges is Rs. 650.52 Lacs as against Rs. 666.46 Lacs for the previous year. However the net loss for the current year is Rs. 30.60 Lacs as against the previous year profit of Rs. 214.74 Lacs mainly due to higher depreciation charges of Rs. 141.23 Lacs (due to change in method of depreciation to W.D.V. in place of S.L.M.) as against Rs. 31.30 Lacs for the previous year. The company is facing liquidity crunch due to delay/non-receipt of Central Subsidy and for which your directors are taking requisite measures to Improve/receive the cashflow/ subsidy.

5. FUTURE PROSPECTS :

The Indian Meteorological Department has forecasted that there will be a 11th successive normal rainfall of the country, which will increase the demand of the product of your company, which is in short supply.

The Madhya Pradesh government has lifted the restriction places on fixed ratio percentage on the sales of fertilisers in respect of MARKFED v/s PRIVATE TRADE. Which in turn will further boost the sales of your company as M.P. is one of the largest consuming centre of Single Super Phosphate . We expect the future prospect of the industry and your company is bright.
