In view of the losses, your directors regret their inability to declare any dividend.

GENERAL REVIEW & PROSPECTS

The market in 1998 for Darjeeling tea was extremely poor with prices reaching record low levels. In fact, Darjeeling tea fetched prices lower than Assam CTC tea - a phenomenon unprecedented so far. The prices for even the best quality Darjeeling tea were miserably low. The usual increase in cost resulting from rise in wages and cost of power and fuel added to the problems. The results of the Company include cost incurred during two lean seasons and would not have shown losses on an annualised basis.

In view of the market conditions witnessed in 1998, the prospects for Darjeeling tea does not hold out much promise particularly due to stagnant production and ever-increasing costs of inputs. During the period under review, the sale of Longview Tea Estate and Riverview Project in North Dinajpur were concluded. Negotiations for the sale of Sannyasithan Tea Estate have also been completed.

DIRECTORS

Shri S.K. Kejriwal, has resigned from the directorship. Your directors place on record their appreciation of the valuable advice rendered by him during his tenure.

Shri P.K. Daga retires by rotation, but being eligible, offers himself for reappointment.

AUDITORS AND AUDITORS' REPORT

The notes referred to by the Auditors in their report are self-explanatory and do not require any further elucidation. The Statutory Auditors of the Company, M/s. Lodha & Company, Chartered Accountants, Calcutta retire at the ensuing Annual General Meeting of the Company and being eligible, offer themselves for re-appointment.
