Costs of key raw materials have gone up. Competition has become more keen. Despite these difficulties, we have increased our market share. What's more, we have been successful in cutting costs.






Irfan Pathan, an alumnus of the MRF Pace Foundation, was declared the ICC emerging player of the year' for 2004.
