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



Sponge Iron

MSP Sponge Iron Plant uses the highest grade of Iron Ore available along with the best quality coal. This ensures very high metallization of Sponge Iron.

MS Billets

MSP produces high grade MS Billets through Induction Furnace-Continuous Caster route. High grade Sponge Iron produced in -house is used to produce Steel that undergoes strict quality control and meets all quality parameters. MS Billets is used as raw material for our Re-Rolling Mill.



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Construction Bars (TMT)

MSP uses 'Thermex' technology to produce highgrade quality TMT Bars that exhibits high yield point, surface hardness, toughness, ductility and weldability conforming to ISI standards. MSP is certified under ISO 9001: 2000 and are approved suppliers to major Infrastructure and Housing Projects in India. MSP has wide marketing network to market its product throughout India.

Captive Coal Washery



Power
