Definition

Deositories Act: 'Depositories Act' means the Depositories Act, 1996 and shall include any statutory modification(s) or re-enactment thereof for the time being in force.

Depository: Depository' means a Company formed and registered under the Companies Act, 1956, and which has been granted a Certificate of registration under Sub-section (1A) of section 12 of the Securities and Exchange Board of India Act, 1992.

Beneficial Oswner: 'Beneficial Odwner' means a person whose name is recorded as such with a depository.

Shareholder or Member: 'Shareholder' or 'Member' means the duly registered holder of the shares from time to time and includes the subscribers to the Memorandum of Association of the Company and the beneficial owner(s) as defined in clause (a) of sub-section (1) of Section 2 of the Depositories Act. 1996.

Security: 'Security' means such security as may be specified by the SEBI Board from time to time.

SEBI: 'SEBI' means the Securities Exchange Board of India.

b. Dematerialisation of securities:

Either on the Company or on the investor exercising of option to hold his securities with a depository in a dematerialised form, the Company shall enter into an agreement with the depositors to coable the investor to dematerialise the social field, in which event the rights and obligations of the parties concerned shall be governed by the Demonstrates Act.

c. Options for Investors:

ivery Person subscribing to securitary officed by the Company shall have the obtion to receive the security Certificates or hold Securities with a consister:

If a person opts to hold his security will a decository, the Company shall intimate such depository the details of allotment of security, and on receipt of such information, the depository shall enter in its record the name of the allottee as the beneficial owner of the security.

All securities held by a depository shal be dematerialised and shall be in a fungible form;

Nothing contained in Sections 153, 153A, 153B, 187A, 187B, 187C, and 372A of the Act shall apply to a depository in respect of the secrities held by it on behalf of the beneficial owners.

e. Rights of Depositories and beneficial owners:

- 1. Notwithstanding anything to the contrary contained in the Articles, a depository shall be deemed to be a registered owner for the purposes of effecting transfer of security on behalf of the beneficial owner:
- 2. Save as otherwise provided in 1 above, the depository as a registered owner shall not have any voting rights or any other rights in respect of securities held by it:
- 3. Every person holding equity share capital of the Company and whose name is entered as beneficial owner in the records of the depository shallo be deemed to be a member of the Company. The beneficial owner shall be entitled to all the rights and benefits and be subjected to all the liabilities in respect of the securities held by a depository.

f. "Service of the Documents:

Notwithstanding anything contained in the Act or these Articles to the contrary, where securities are held in a depository mode, the records of the beneficial owner may be served by a depository on the combany by means of electronic mode or by delivery of floppies or discs?

g. Transfer of Securities:

Notwithstanding containes in Section 105 of the Act or those Articles shall apply to transfer of sections effected by a transferor and transferor both of whom are entered at bone fixed owner and the hopositories act, 1786.

h. Allotment of Securities dealt with a depository :
