DIVIDEND:

The Directors are pleased to recommend dividend of 20% (previous year 20%) for the year ended 31st March, 1997, which, if approved by the members at the Annual General Meeting will absorb a sum of Rs.78.85 lacs inclusive of dividend tax.

OPERATIONS:

Sales during the year have been recorded at Rs. 2883.98 lacs as against Rs. 2092.70 lacs during the previous year. Total income including income from Turning Division, for the year amounted to Rs. 3185.44 lacs marking an increase of 22.43%. The production however was affected due to power shortage in Gujarat.

DIRECTORS:

Pursuant to the provisions of the Companies Act, 1956 and the Articles of Association of the Company, Mr. Y.H. Malegam and Mr. B. R. Patel,

Directors, retire by rotation and being eligible, offer themselves for reappointment.

AUDITORS:

M/s. Parikh & Shah, the present auditors, have furnished a Certificate regarding their eligibility for reappointment as Company's Auditors pursuant to Section 224(1B) of the Companies Act, 1956.

CONSERVATION OF ENERGY:

The Company has installed electronic devices to check electrical consumption and waste of power. High power loads staggered to control the maximum demand.

TECHNOLOGY ABSORPTION:

The Company has no technical collaboration and therefore absorption of technology is not applicable.
