

Pharmaceuticals

In 1989, Yashwant Gopal Bane was diagnosed as having elevated growth of uric acid in the blood. A team of doctors comprising nephrologists Dr Ashok L. Kirplani and Dr Hemant Mehta and diabetologist Dr Vijay S. Ajgaonkar recommended dialysis, a painful but necessary process, and subsequently a kidney transplant.

Bane, then 57, decided to go in for a kidney transplant and underwent surgery in January 1992 at the Raheja Hospital in Mumbai under attending Drs Ajit Phadke and Umesh Oza. Crop Protection
