NOTICE

NOTICE is hereby given that the Thirty-third Annual General Meeting of the members of the Company will be held at Patkar Hall, S.N.D.T. University, 1, Nathibai Thackersey Road, Mumbai 400 020 on Monday, September 22, 1997, at 3.30 p.m. to transact the following business:

- 1. To receive, consider and adopt the Audited Profit and Loss Account for the year ended June 30, 1997, the Balance Sheet as at that date, the Directors' and Auditors' Reports thereon.
- 2. To declare dividend for the accounting year ended June 30, 1997.
- 3. To appoint a Director in place of Mr. A. G. Lafley, who retires by rotation and being eligible, offers himself for re-election.
- 4. To appoint a Director in place of Mr. C. C. Daley, who retires by rotation and being eligible, offers himself for re-election.
- 5. To appoint Auditors to hold office from the conclusion of this meeting until the conclusion of the next Annual General Meeting on such remuneration and reimbursement of out-of-pocket expenses as the Board may decide.
- 6. To consider and, if thought fit, to pass with or without modification/s, if any, the following Resolution as an Ordinary Resolution:

"RESOLVED THAT Mr. D1 Jager who was appointed as Director to fill in a casual vacancy in terms of Section 262 of the Companies Act, 1956, and holds such office until this Annual General Meeting and in respect of whom the Company has received a notice in writing from a member under Section 257 of the Companies Act, 1956, signifying his intention to propose Mr.D I Jager's candidature for the office of Director, be and is hereby appointed as a Director of the Company, liable to retire by rotation."

7. To consider and, if thought fit, to pass with or without modification/s, if any, the following Resolution as an Ordinary Resolution:

"RESOLVED THAT Mr. H. Meixner who was appointed as Additional Director in terms of Section 260 of the Companies Act, 1956, and holds such office until this Annual General Meeting and in respect of whom the Company has received a notice in writing from a member under Section 257 of the Companies Act, 1956, signifying his intention to propose Mr. H. Meixner's candidature for the office of Director, be and is hereby appointed as a Director of the Company, liable to retire by rotation."

8. To consider and, if thought fit, to pass with or without modification/s, if any, the following Resolution as an Ordinary Resolution:

"RESOLVED THAT subject to the provisions of Section 198, 269, 309, 310 and 311 and other applicable provisions, if any, of the Companies Act, 1956, the approval of the Company be and is hereby accorded to the appointment of Mr. S. Bhattacharya as Vice Chairman & Managing Director of the Company for a period of four years with effect from July 1, 1997, on such terms and conditions as the Board may consider appropriate, provided, however, that the terms of remuneration of Mr. S. Bhattacharya shall not exceed the ceilings as set out in Schedule XIII to the Companies Act, 1956 as amended from time to time and such other guidelines as may be issued hereafter in this behalf."

"RESOLVED FURTHER THAT Board of Directors be and is hereby authorized to pay a commission in accordance with the provisions of Section 309 and other applicable provisions of the Companies Act, 1956, in addition to the salary and perquisites, to Mr. S. Bhattacharya."

"RESOLVED FURTHER THAT the Board of Directors be and is hereby authorized to take all necessary or desirable steps for the purpose of effecting this appointment and matters incidental thereto."

9. To consider and, if thought fit, to pass with or without modification/s, if any, the following Resolutions as Ordinary Resolutions:

"RESOLVED THAT:

(a) the authorized capital of the Company be increased from Rs.15 00 00 000 (Rupees fifteen crores) divided into

- 1 50 00 000 (One crore fifty lakhs) equity shares of Rs.10 (Rupees ten only) each to Rs.25 00 00 000 (Rupees twenty-five crores only) divided into 2 50 00 000 (Two crores fifty lakhs) equity shares of Rs.10 (Rupees ten only) each.
- (b) the words "The share capital of the Company is Rs.25 00 00 000 (Rupees twenty-five crores only) divided into 2 50 00 000 (Two crores fifty lakhs) equity shares of Rs.10 (Ten) each" be substituted for the words "The share capital of the Company is Rs.15 00 00 000 (Rupees fifteen crores only) divided into 1 50 00 000 (One crore fifty lakhs) equity shares of Rs. 10 (Rupees ten) each in Clause V of Company's Memorandum of Association".
- 10. To consider and, if thought fit, to pass with or without modification/s, if any, the following Resolution as a Special Resolution:
- "RESOLVED THAT the Articles of Association of the Company be altered by substituting the following new Article 3 for the present Article 3 thereof:
- '3. The present Authorized Share Capital of the Company consists of Rs.25 00 00 000 (Rupees twenty-five crores only) divided into 2 50 00 000 (Two crores fifty lakhs) equity shares of Rs.10/- (Rupees ten only) each'."
- 11. To consider and, if thought fit, to pass with or without modification/s, if any, the following Resolution as a Special Resolution:

"RESOLVED THAT:

(a) pursuant to Article 165 of the Company's Articles of Association and subject to the approval of the Reserve Bank of India and other necessary approvals, the sum of Rs.7 21 34 970 (Rupees seven crores twenty-one lakhs thirty-four thousand nine hundred seventy only) from the Share Premium Account of the Company be capitalized and that the same be applied on behalf of persons whose names stand on the Register of Members of the Company on such date as may be hereafter fixed by the Board of Directors (hereinafter referred to as "the said date") in payment in full for 72 13 497 (Seventy-two lakhs thirteen thousand four hundred ninety-seven) new equity shares of the Company of Rs.10 (Rupees ten) each and that such new equity shares be allotted and issued

- credited as fully paid to such persons in the proportion of one new equity share for every two existing equity shares held by such persons respectively and that the shares so distributed shall be treated for all purposes as an increase in the nominal amount of the capital of the Company held by each such member and not as income;
- (b) any of such new equity shares which on an exact distribution in the proportion aforesaid, would fall to be allotted in fraction, be allotted in the name of a Director of the Company upon trust to sell the same and divide the net proceeds amongst the shareholders entitled to such fractions prorata in accordance with their rights;
- (c) the new equity shares be allotted subject to the Memorandum and Articles of Association of the Company;
- (d) the new equity shares shall, on allotment, rank pari passu in all respects with the existing issued equity shares of the Company;
- (e) the Board of Directors be and is hereby authorized to take all necessary or desirable steps for this purpose and matters incidental thereto.
- 12. To consider and, if thought fit, to pass with or without modifications, if any, the following Resolution as a Special Resolution:
- "RESOLVED THAT pursuant to Section 31 and other applicable provisions, if any, of the Companies Act, 1956, (including any statutory modifications or reenactment thereof for the time being in force), the existing Article 23 of the Articles of Association of the Company be substituted by the following new Article 23.
- '23. The Company shall have power, subject to and in accordance with all applicable provisions of the Companies Act, 1956, if and when any statutory amendments thereto or any re-enactment thereof empowers the Company so to do, to buy-back any of its own shares whether fully paid-up or party paid-up".
- "RESOLVED FURTHER THAT the Board of Directors be and is hereby authorized to do all such acts, deeds, matters and things as may be considered necessary, desirable or expedient for giving effect to this resolution."
- 13. To consider and, if thought fit, to pass with or without modification/s if any, the following Resolution as a Special Resolution.

"RESOLVED THAT consent of the Company be and is hereby accorded to buy back equity shares of the Company on such terms and conditions as it may deem fit, as and when Companies Act, 1956 is amended to enable companies to buy back their own shares, subject to such condition as may be prescribed in this behalf from time to time, and as set out in further detail in the Explanatory Statement annexed hereto, so that the aggregate amount to be utilized by the Company from its Share Premium Account for such buy back shall not exceed Rs. 85 crores."

"RESOLVED FURTHER THAT the Board of Directors be and is hereby authorized to do all such act, deeds, matters and things as may be necessary to carry out the aforesaid intention in due compliance of law."

(Pursuant to Section 173 of the Companies Act, 1956)

Item No. 6

Mr. D. I. Jager was appointed to fill in the casual vacancy in terms of Section 262 of the Companies Act, 1956, and holds the office upto the date of this Annual General Meeting. The Company has received a notice and deposit pursuant to Section 257 of the Companies Act, 1956, from a member of the Company proposing Mr. Jager's candidature for the office of Director. Mr. Jager has vast business experience. Your Directors, therefore, recommend his appointment to the Board as it will be beneficial to the Company.

None of the Directors, except Mr. Jager, is concerned or interested in this resolution.

Item No. 7

Mr. H. Meixner was appointed as additional Director in terms of Section 260 of the Companies Act, 1956, and holds the office upto the date of this Annual General Meeting. The Company has received a notice and deposit pursuant to Section 257 of the Companies Act, 1956, from

a member of the Company proposing Mr. Meixner's candidature for the office of Director. Mr. Meixner has vast business experience. Your Directors, therefore, recommend his appointment to the Board as it will be beneficial to the Company.

None of the Directors, except Mr. Meixner, is concerned or interested in this resolution.

Item No. 8

Mr. S. Bhattacharya joined the Company in 1982 as Finance Director responsible for the overall financial operations of the Company. In view of his vast experience and valuable contribution to the growth of Company's business, the Board recommends his appointment as the Vice Chairman & Managing Director. He is an Engineering Graduate from Indian Institute of Technology, Kharagpur, with Masters Degree in Engineering from University of California, Berkeley and MBA in Finance from University of Houston, USA.

The Board of Directors, subject to the approval of the shareholders, has appointed Mr. S. Bhattacharya as Vice Chairman & Managing Director of your Company for a period of four years with effect from July 1, 1997 on the following terms and conditions:

(i) Salary:

Upto Rs. 18,00,000/- (Rupees Eighteen Lakhs) per annum.

(ii) Commission:

1% Commission of the net profits of the Company subject to a ceiling of 50% of the salary per annum, whichever is less.

(iii) Perquisites:

In addition to the above, Mr. S. Bhattacharya shall also be entitled to perquisites like free furnished accommodation, gas, electricity, water, furnishings, medical reimbursement, leave travel concession, club fees, personal accident insurance and other perquisites in accordance with the policy of the Company provided however that such perquisites shall be restricted to Rs.9,00,000/- (Rupees Nine Lakhs) per annum. For the purposes of calculating the above ceiling, perquisites shall be evaluated as per the Income-tax rules wherever

applicable. In the absence of such a rule, perquisites shall be evaluated at factual, provided however that use of company's car for the official duties and telephone at residence including payment of local and long distance calls shall not be included in the computation of perquisites for the purpose of calculating the said ceiling. Company's contribution to Provident Fund, Superannuation Fund or Annuity fund and Gratuity Fund will also not be included in the computation of ceiling on the perquisites.

(iv) Board of Directors shall be entitled to revise the above remuneration of Mr. S. Bhattacharya provided however, the terms of remuneration of Mr. Bhattacharya shall not exceed the ceilings as set out in Schedule XIII to the Companies Act, 1956, as amended from time to time.

Your Directors, therefore, consider that his appointment as the Vice Chairman & Managing Director will be beneficial to the Company.

The Board recommends passing an Ordinary Resolution.

None of the Directors except Mr. S. Bhattacharya is concerned or interested in this Resolution.

ITEM NOS. 9 AND 10

The present authorized share capital of the Company is Rs.15 00 00 000 divided into 1 50 00 000 equity shares of Rs.10 each. The present issued share capital of the Company is Rs.14 42 69 940 and on the issue of bonus shares will increase to Rs.21 64 04 910. For this purpose, it is proposed that the Company increase its authorized share capital to Rs.25 00 00 000 divided into 2 50 00 000 equity shares of Rs.10 each. Hence the ordinary resolution at item 9 of the Notice.

The ordinary resolution at item 9 and the special resolution at item 10 of the Notice are consequential upon the proposed increase in the authorised share capital of the Company.

ITEM NO. 11

The Directors consider that the issued share capital of the Company should be brought into closer relationship with the capital employed in the business. The Board, therefore, recommends that an aggregate sum of Rs.7,21,34,970 from the Share Premium account of the

Company be capitalized and the same be applied by issuing 72,13,497 new equity shares of Rs.10 each credited as fully paid up to the holders of equity shares of the Company whose names appear on the Company's Register of Members on a date to be determined by the Board in the proportion and on the terms and conditions set out in the special resolution.

The bonus shares on allotment will rank pari passu in all respects with the existing issued equity shares of the Company.

Respective shareholdings which are not divisible by 2 give rise to fractional entitlements. As the work and expense of distributing fractional coupons would be disproportionate to the benefit that may accrue to the shareholders, it is proposed that the aggregate of such fractions be allotted to a Director upon trust to sell the same and distribute the net proceeds to the shareholders pro rata to their fractional entitlements. The aggregate of such fractions is likely to be a negligible percentage of the total issue and Directors are of the view that in the circumstances, the proposed manner of dealing with fractional entitlements is in the best interest of the Company and its members.

Board recommends that the resolution at Item 11 be passed as a Special Resolution.

ITEM NO. 12 AND 13

The Companies Act, 1956, presently restricts the purchase of its own shares by a Company unless the same is done with a view to reduce its capital. As the members may be aware, the Companies Act, 1956, is proposed to be amended shortly by incorporating a provision enabling the companies to buy back their own shares subject to certain conditions as may be prescribed under the proposed amendment. As mentioned in the resolution, the aggregate amount to be utilized by the Company for scuh buy back shall not exceed Rs. 85 crores. The Company proposes to complete the buy back within 15

months from the date of passing of the resolution or from the date on which the amended Companies Act comes into force, whichever is later. Such buy back shall either be for reduction of capital, or, if permissible, for re-issue of shares as the Board may decide from time to time including to the employees of the Company, provided that such re-issue shall not be made before the expiry of a period, as may be prescribed in this behalf, from the date of such buy back of shares. Re-issue of such shares would further motivate the employees towards achieving better business results leading to higher shareholder value.

As your Directors are of the opinion that the buy back of shares as above will lead to improvement in the intrinsic worth of the equity shares and is considered beneficial to the shareholders, the proposed resolution is placed before you for your approval.

In order to enable the Company to buy back its own shares, it is necessary to amend existing Article 23 of Articles of Association of the Company and substitute with a new article thereto as set out at item No. 12 of the accompanying notice.

None of the directors of the Company is in any way concerned or interested in either of the above resolution, save and except to the extent of their shareholdings in the Company.
