We have audited the attached Balance Sheet of **KAYTON TRADE AND FINANCE LIMITED**, as on 31st March, 2000 and also the annexed Profit & Loss Account for the year ended on 31st March, 2000, and report that :-

1. We have obtained all the information and explanation which to the best of our knowledge and belief were necessary for the purpose of our audit.
2. In our opinion, proper books of accounts as required by law have been kept by the company so far as appears from our examination of those books.
3. The Balance Sheet and Profit and Loss Account dealt with in this report are in agreement with the books of accounts.
4. In our opinion, the profit & loss account and balance sheet comply with Mandatory Accounting Standards referred to in sub-section (3C) of section 211 of Companies Act, 1956.
5. In our opinion and to the best of our knowledge and according to the explanations given to us, the accounts read with the notes appearing thereon give the information required by the companies Act, 1956, in the manner so required and give a true and fair view:-
