### PRODUCTION:

#### Chains And Sprockets:

The year under review was a very difficult for the industry due to uncertain political situation. Industrial growth suffered and demand for the products was slackened. In order to face severe recessionery competition, Company had to sell its products at lower the prices which resulted in reduction of sales for the year. Viewed in this conditions, the company's Sales and other income for the year 1997-98 amounted to Rs. 14.04 crores as against Rs. 16.12 crores of the previous year.

#### Wind Mills:

During the year the mills have generated 3,84,234 units.

Against the units generated at Lamba, credit for equal units in consumption will be given every month to Rolcon Eng. Co. Ltd., Vallabh Vidyanagar, by Gujarat Electricity Board. Due to the severe cyclone, which took place in the coastal areas of Saurashtra/Kutch regions on 9th June, 1998,

severe damage to the Wind Mills was reported. One Wind Mill valuing, Rs. 99 Lacs (Net Rs. 33 lacs) located at Lamba was completely damaged and destroyed.

#### **DIRECTORS:**

Shri Ashok K. Parikh and Shri Bhulabhai D. Patel, Directors retire under Article 138 of the Articles of Association of the Company and being eligible offer themselves for re-appointment.

Mr. Rolf Bovenkamp tendered his resignation due to ill health. Your directors have placed on record their appreciation of the valuable services rendered from time to time since inception of the company. His knowledge and experience in the field of engineering was instrumental in achieving our goal.

Mr. Knut Bovenkamp was appointed as a non retiring director since 1st May,1998. He has worked with Mr. Rolf Bovenkamp and our ex director Mr. Hans Hermann Bovenkamp. Mr. Knut Bovenkamp is a Managing Director of M/s. Kohler & Bovenkamp GMBH + Co our collaborators. His acumen in the manufacture of chains and sprocket would be considered as additional advantage in our activities.

## ANNEXURE TO THE DIRECTORS' REPORT

INFORMATION AS PER SECTION 217 (1) (e) READ WITH COMPANIES (DISCLOSURE OF PARTICULARS IN THE REPORT OF DIRECTORS) RULES, 1988 AND FORMING PART OF THE DIRECTORS' REPORT FOR THE YEAR ENDED 31st MARCH, 1998.

## A. CONSERVATION OF ENERGY:

- (a) Energy Conservation Measures Taken:
  - Company have installed additional 25 KVA capacitor to the existing main line circuit which save energy consumption. Company have successfully installed and commissoned 2 nos of wind Turbine Electric Generators of 450 KW, out of which one is not operating since 9th June, 1998.
- (b) Additional Investments and proposals, if any being implemented for reduction of consumption of energy.
  - i) Investments by way of installation of capacitors have been completed to achieve the power factor of 0.98 to 0.99.
  - ii) Electric Furnaces have been converted into diesel fire heating furnaces out of which some of them have been converted into L.D.O. fire heating furnaces.
  - iii) Electrical motors with high HP have been converted into lower HP as per the calculation of mechanical BHP.
  - iv) For higher H.P. machines capacitors are installed to conserve the electric energy.
- Impact of the above measures has resulted in reduction of energy consumption and consequent impact on the cost of production of goods.
   Saving in fuel cost was achieved.

# **B. TECHNOLOGY ABSORPTION:**

Efforts made in technology absorption as per form - B of the Annexure to the rules.

#### 1. Research & Development (R&D)

- (a) Specific areas in which R & D carried out by the Company.
  - The Company has installed testing equipments like Automatic Hydraulic Fatigue Testing Machine, Chain Wear life Machine and Micro Hardness Testers for investigating the fatigue life/wear life and hardness of the chains and chain components:
  - ii) CNC machines have been installed to improve productivity and quality of Chains.
  - iii) NC vertical boring mill machine has been installed for manufacture of Sprocket. This ensures accuracy and speedy manufacturing of Sprockets, which ultimately saves time and energy.
  - iv) In order to achieve repetitive accuracies of product company has updated copying S pilot m/c to improve productivity and quality of chains.
