

With a view to strengthen the capital base of the Company and to part finance the on-going expansion of manufacturing facilities, your Directors regret their inability in recommending any dividend for the year under consideration.

(3) Business Prospects

The Company has shown an increase in turnover inspiteof tough competition from the new entrants in the field. It is heartening to note here that your Company is fully equipped to accept and withstand this competition. Various measures are being taken taken as an ongoing process to further improve the performance of the Company at all levels. It is searching new product lines and widening its marketing set-up. The Company has recently entered into a prestigious agreement with The Arvind Mills Ltd. for manufacture and

marketing of readymade garments under its popular brand "Ruf & Tuf". The Company has set-up its machinery to take up this venture and poised for setting up a base for marketing its product throughout the state. It is also in the process of setting up a new manufacturing facility for the purpose. This will benefit the Company by having a widened manufacturing and marketing base and make it possible to stand as one of the major manufacturers in the Readymade Garment Industry of the state. The Company has also obtained ISO 9002 certification from TUV Germany during the year. All these steps are supported by Sales Tax Incentive as provided by the State Government are expected to improve the peformance of your Company at various levels.

Due to the increased competition faced by your Company, the performance level was not as per the projections made. However, as stated above, the Company is taking all the steps to boost its sales performance.
