Your Directors are pleased to present their Annual Report together with the Audited Statement of Accounts for the year ending 31st March, 1997.

## **Operations**

While turnover was the same, the Net profit recorded a rise to Rs 79.29 lacs from Rs 17.82 lacs in the previous year due to the lower expenditure under the Voluntary Retirement Scheme, stringent cost control and other economy measures.

#### Auditor's Remarks

The observations in the Auditor's Report together with the notes forming part of accounts at appropriate places are self explanatory.

Despite the repeated requests and efforts made by the Company to recover the fixed assets records from the previous management, the Company's efforts have not been fruitful. Therefore physical verification was not carried out. However the Company is preparing the list of Fixed Assets on the basis of available data.

Steps are being taken to set up an Internal Audit system and obtain confirmations from various authorities referred to in the report.

## Swastik Undertaking

As per the Scheme of Arrangement sanctioned by the Gujarat High Court order of 24.12.87 the Swastik Undertaking of Ambalal Sarabhai Enterprises Ltd (ASE) was transferred to the Company. The said Scheme had been challenged by the Central Bank of India & Bank of Baroda, the creditors of Ambalal Sarabhai Enterprises Ltd as being vitiated by fraud. The Gujarat High Court, vide its order dated 27.02.97 held that the Order sanctioning the Scheme of Arrangement was liable to be quashed and set aside as being vitiated by fraud. Since the said order was passed on 24.12.87 and ASE had acted upon the said order, a final opportunity was to be given to ASE to reconsider the claims of the Banks and make a proposal that was acceptable to the Banks, within two months from 27.02.97. However no settlement was reached between ASE and the Banks within the said two month period. ASE has gone into appeal against the Order of the Gujarat High Court in the Supreme Court of India and the Supreme Court has granted interim stay of operation of the judgement of the Gujarat High Court.

# **BIFR**

BIFR Hearing took place on 30.07.97. In view of the interim stay granted by the Supreme Court of India, in the appeal filed by Ambalal Sarabhai Enterprises Ltd against the judgement of the Gujarat High Court. ICICI (Operating Agency) has been asked to formulate a Scheme taking into account the legal issues under consideration.

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Information under Section 217 (1) (e) of the Companies Act, 1956.

The Company continues its efforts to improve methods of energy conservation & utilisation. The foreign exchange earnings and outgo was Nil during the year.

Particulars of Employees

There were no employees whose particulars are required to be disclosed under Section 217(2A) of the Companies Act, 1956 read with the Companies (Particulars of Employees) Rules, 1975.
