DIRECTORS' REPORT

Your Directors have pleasure in presenting the 56th Annual Report with Audited Accounts for the year ended 31st March, 2000.

FINANCIAL RESULTS

The Company has achieved a Turnover of Rs. 4488 lakhs as compared to Rs. 4808 lakhs last year. After providing for depreciation of Rs. 102 lakhs finance charges of Rs. 215 lakhs the operations have resulted in a loss of Rs. 245 lakhs as compared to the profit of Rs. 14 lakhs last year. After adjusting last year's surplus brought forward amounting to Rs. 44 lakhs, the loss set off against General Reserve is Rs. 201 lakhs.

OPERATIONS

The Company's operations were affected by the fall in margins on account of steep rise in both power tariff and fuel costs. While power tariff hike affected chlorates, the steep increase in price of lecofines and furnace oil impacted on Barlum Chemicals. The inability to take up selling prices, resulted in major erosion in margins. Moreover the prices had also to be reduced to keep in step with prices of imported chemicals. In this context Government of India has imposed an anti-dumping duty on Barlum Carbonate of Chinese origin and this will result in better performance in the coming years. The doubling of excise duty on pesticides in general and Copper Sulphate in particular as also Sales Tax hikes affected company's turnover in the IVth quarter of the year. The Company's operations resulted in a loss for the first time in the last 13 years. Appropriate measures are being taken to remedy the situation.

DIVIDEND

In view of the above, the Directors do not recommend payment of dividend to its shareholders for the year 1999-2000.

PUBLIC DEPOSITS

As of 31st March, 2000 Five deposits amounting to Rs.15000 remained unclaimed.
