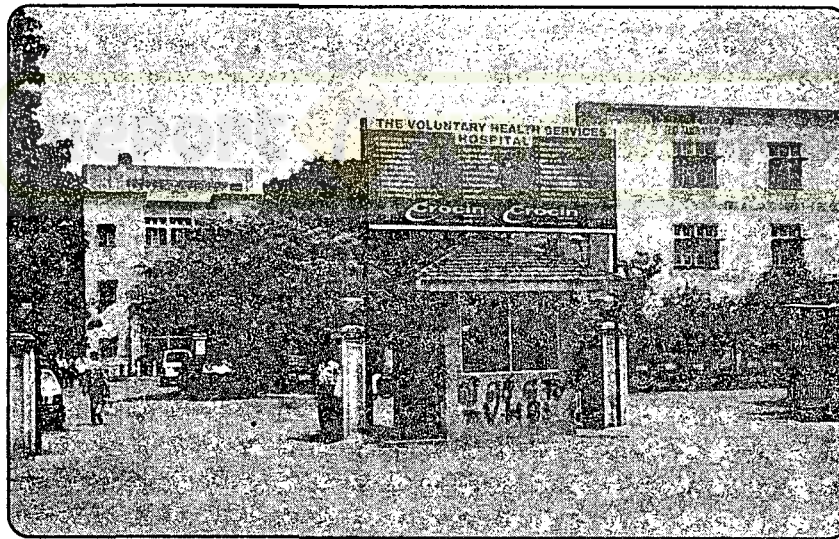

ANNUAL REPORT FOR THE YEAR 2006 – 2007

The 48th Annual General Meeting of the Society was held on 27 September 2006 at VHS. As on 31 March 2007, there were 1558 patrons and 287 life members. During the year under report, the Central Committee met 3 times.

The 7th B.L. Ratan Memorial Lecture was delivered on 14 July 2006 by Dr. Kalaichelvi, Professor of Oncology, Madras Medical College & Oncologist, IOG, Chennai, on "Screening and Early Detection of Cancer in Women".

The 4th M.V. Arunachalam Endowment Oration was delivered on 26 August 2006 by Prof. Srinath Reddy, Professor & HOD of Cardiothoracic Surgery, AIIMS, on "Medical & Scientific Journalism: A 20th century perspective". A Symposium on "The Art of Medical and Scientific Communication" presided over by Mr. M.V. Murugappan, Trustee, Vellayan Chettiar Trust, was also held that day.

The 11th ALNC Day and Oration was delivered on 22 September 2006 by Prof. S.N. Bhagwati, Head, Department of Neurosurgery, Bombay Hospital, Mumbai, on "Rational Management of Craniopharyngioma".

The 20th K. Gopalakrishna Endowment Lecture was delivered by Prof. Christopher J. Mathias, Professor of Clinical Neurology, Imperial College and University College, London, on "Dear Doctor I am Dizzy: What should I do?" on 23 September 2006, along with a Symposium on "Autonomic Dysfunction: An interdisciplinary approach".

A World Stroke Day Doctors' Forum was organised by the Department of Neurology on 27 October 2006 in collaboration with the Indian Medical Association, Chennai South.

The 8th E.S. Krishnamoorthy Memorial Lecture was delivered on 12 November 2006 by Prof. Peter Whitehouse, Director, Integrative Studies, Department of Neurology, Case Western Reserve University, and Professor of Neurology, University Memory and Aging Center, University Hospitals of Cleveland, USA on "Who's Life is it Anyway? Ethical issues, in caring for elderly people".

On the occasion of National Epilepsy Day on 18 November 2006, The Institute of Neurological Sciences, VHS (TINS-VHS) arranged the launch of Professional and People Forums on the "epi-life.org" portal by Ms. Kalaimamani Sukanya, the well-known cine/TV personality.

In conjunction with the Indian Psychiatric Society's Annual Congress on 7 January 2007, TINS-VHS arranged a series of lectures: "How the Brain and Mind Work!" by Prof. V.S. Ramachandran, University of California at San Diego, USA; "Enhancing the Human Brain – possibilities and pitfalls!" by Prof. Perminder Sachdev, University of New South Wales, Australia; and "Can We Age-proof our Brains?" by Dr. Murali Doraisamy, Duke University, USA.

Nobel Laureate Dr. Amartya Sen delivered the 14th K.S. Sanjivi Endowment Lecture on "Health and the Society" on 10 February 2007 to a packed audience at the K.S. Sanjivi Auditorium, VHS. Dr. M.S. Swaminathan presided over the function.

The 27th T.S. Srinivasan Endowment Oration "On Viruses, Genes and Mad Cows: Lessons from Prion disease" was delivered on 17 February by Nobel Laureate Prof. Stanley Prusiner, University of California, San Francisco, USA. Mr. Venu Srinivasan presided.

New Initiatives

The IOB Outpatient-Emergency and K.S. Sanjivi Auditorium Block, constructed with the donation from the Indian Overseas Bank, was formally inaugurated on 10 August 2006 by Mr. T.S. Narayanasami, Chairman, Indian Overseas Bank, Chennai, at a well-attended function. Also inaugurated the same day were the Mary Shelvankar Seminar Hall by the donor, Mrs. Menaka Parthasarathy, and the S. Anantharamakrishnan Staff Floor (donated by M/s. TAFE) and the new Administration Wing by Dr. M.S. Swaminathan. VHS records its thanks to all the donors who have helped us realise this long-felt need.

On the occasion of World Diabetes Day on 25 November 2006, with Mr. Suresh Bapalal Mehta as the Chief Guest, the "Varsa Suresh Bapalal Mehta Hall and Table Tennis Centre" was inaugurated by Mr. V. Chandrasekar, the former National Table Tennis Champion.

Using part of the donation of USD 50,000 made last year by the Association of Tamil Nadu Medical Graduates (ATMG) Charitable Foundation, USA, the VHS Community Health Department built a large multipurpose community hall for the tsunami-affected village at New Kalpakkam to be used for social functions, community meetings and evening educational programmes. The community hall was opened on 8 January 2007 by Mr. David T. Hopper, the Consul General of the USA in Chennai, when Dr. S.F. Rahman and Dr. V. Srinivasan, representatives of ATMG, were also present. The remaining part of the donation will be used towards construction of a Mini Health Centre at Pattipuram once the government land formalities are completed.

Also opened by Mr. Hopper the same day was a community toilet built at Nemmelikuppam with the donation of Rs. 5 lakh from MCKS Food for Hungry Foundation, in the presence of Mr. T.R. Sridharan, Managing Trustee of the Foundation.

Out of the donation of Rs. 3.8 lakh by the Rangammal Gopalachari Trust, a Mini Health Centre was constructed at Sithalapakkam, which has been named the Rangammal Gopalachari-VHS Mini Health Centre. This too was opened by Mr. Hopper on 8 January 2007. Mr. Ravi Natarajan of the Trust attended the function.

The extension of the VHS-Rotary Club of Madras Senior Citizen Centre was commissioned on 2 March 2007. This extension has 10 double occupancy and 7 single occupancy rooms, a common room, dining hall and kitchen, an office, and a room with toilet for the caretaker. A small garden is also being nurtured within the complex. All the rooms have already been taken up.

Annual Report

A new transfusion facility for children with thalassaemia was inaugurated on 3 March 2007 at the Rotary Central-TTK-VHS Blood Bank, which will be run in collaboration with the Thalassaemia Welfare Association, TTK Foundation, and the Rotary Club of Madras. The centre organises free blood transfusion, every month, for children with thalassaemia, which is a genetic blood disorder.

The long-awaited sewerage connection from the Chennai Metropolitan Water Supply and Sewerage Board (CMWSSB) was given after paying the required fee and advance tax to the Board. A new collection chamber has been constructed, along with laying of new chambers all along the southern side of the hospital, to let out the sewage stream into the CMWSSB connecting point.

Finance

Donations received during the year totalled Rs. 232.39 lakh (2005–2006: Rs 172.62 lakh), besides Rs. 0.76 lakh by way of individual foreign contributions. The list of donations received as well as particulars of Specific Endowments and details of the Reserve Fund of the Society as on 31 March 2007 are appended.

Also appended are the Auditors' Report and the Balance Sheet of VHS as on 31 March 2007, and the Income and Expenditure Account of the institution, for the year 2006–2007.

Expenditure during the year exceeded income by Rs. 61.79 lakh (2005–2006: Rs. 34.00 lakh).
